Using Goodwood vehicles, deliver Goodwood food products to London, West Sussex, Hampshire and local wholesale customers.

## Key responsibilities

- Carryout multi-drop deliveries of Goodwood produce mainly but not exclusively to London over night
- Lift and stack the van with Goodwood products
- Complete all associated paperwork (temperature sheets, delivery notes etc)
- Ensure the van is checked before use and any faults reported
- Ensure vehicles are cleaned (inside and out) and filled with fuel after each run
- Be polite and courteous to customers at all times
- Other duties as requested by the Distribution Supervisor

<b>What do you need to be successful?</b>

- Hold a current, clean, full driving licence and CPC qualification
- At least 2 years’ proven driving experience, preferably with multi-drop experience
- Good literacy and numeracy skills in order to process deliveries
- Own or reliable transport to get to and from work
- Must be able to meet eligibility requirements for company vehicle insurance
- Desirable;
  - HACCP (training can be provided); basic food hygiene certificate (training can be provided); previous experience of delivering temperature controlled products
  - Knowledge of local area, West and East Sussex and Hampshire
